Cutting Half-Square Triangles

Easily cut half-square triangles for *Harvest Day* using the Fons & Porter Half & Quarter Ruler.

Cutting Half-Square Triangles

1. Straighten the left edge of 4½"-wide fabric strip. Place the 4½" line of the Fons & Porter Half & Quarter Ruler on the bottom edge of strip, aligning left edge of ruler with straightened edge of strip. The yellow tip of ruler will extend beyond top edge of strip.
2. Cut along right edge of ruler to make 1 half-square triangle (*Photo A*).
3. Turn ruler and align 4½" line with top edge of strip. Cut along right edge of ruler (*Photo B*).
4. Repeat to cut required number of half-square triangles.
