

PRISM

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FP9 Ribbons *Plus* Wrap

Materials:

Approx 550 yds assorted Ribbons & textured yarns

We used:

- 1 Prism Super Dazzle
- 1 Prism Bon Bon
- 1 Prism 1/4" Sparkle Ribbon
- 1 Prism Cleo
- 1 Prism Sunshine
- 2 Prism Rococo
- 1 pair each size 15 US & 17 US needles
- Size K crochet hook

Note: entire wrap is worked in garter stitch (knit every row), changing yarn **every row**. Cut yarn, leaving a 10" tail, and tie new yarn to tail, evening up ends and making a simple over-hand knot. Snug knot up to knitting. Fringe is made as you work, and will be trimmed at end. Alternate yarns as desired, using those with higher yardage more often. There is no need for a rigid a, b, c rotation.

Wrap: With # 17 needle and any smooth yarn, CO 130 sts. Change to # 15 needles and next yarn, tying as described in note above. Knit every row, and at the same time, **increase at beg & k2tog at end every other row** (this makes ends slanted). When piece is approx 18" wide, lain flat, and most of the yarns have been used, BO all sts with #17 needle.

Finishing:

With size K crochet hook and Rococo, fasten to beg of one long edge and work *ch 3, skip 1 st, sc in next st*; rep from * to * along long edges only. Fasten off, leaving long tails as part of fringe. Cut any remaining yarns into 20" lengths for additional fringe. Tie to fringed edge in pairs, spread along edge to fill in. Trim fringe evenly.



Texture plus color adds up to sheer drama in a playful wrap that shows ribbons to best advantage. The more the merrier, and the knitting is easy. Ends are cut and tied for fringe as new yarns are added—so no ends to bury!
