

*Sewing machines for the series are the Bernina® aurora 440 Quilters Edition, Bernina® artista 200E with Embroidery Module, and Bernina® activa 240 QE. For patchwork, we use the #37 patchwork presser foot or the new #57 foot.*

*We use basic sewing supplies such as fabric, rotary cutters, scissors, and rulers, plus specific items listed below. We wear a Klutz cut-resistant safety glove when we rotary cut, press with a Maytag® Cordless Iron, and measure with Omnigrid and Omnigrip rulers. We use many fabrics from Moda®. Patterns and instructions for quilts featured are in Love of Quilting magazine.*

**601. Off the Beaten Path:** 28 mm rotary cutter, Fons & Porter Curved Seam Template Set. (Instructions for *Off the Beaten Path* are in the March/April 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**602. Diagonally Set Quilts:** Fons & Porter Need-To-Know Card, Omnigrip #205 20½" square.

**603. Bodacious Bloomers:** Rotary cutter with deckle, wave, pinking, and straight blades, fusible web, low-loft batting. (Instructions for Bodacious Bloomers quilts are in the May/June 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**604. Needlepunch Embellishment:** Bernina® Needle Punch Accessory Set, hand-dyed felted wool fat quarters, miscellaneous wool and other fibers, *Winter Flowers* and *Lucy's Stocking* patterns from Tricia Anderson, Haiki Two pattern from The Sewing Workshop.

**605. Baby Room Accessories:** Fairfield Nu-Foam® Baby Bumper Pads and poly-fil® Bumper Batting. (Instructions for nursery set are in the July/August 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**606. Machine Quilting:** Quilt Sew Easy by Heavenly Notions, Soft Grip Oval Quilt Clips, Collins Curved Basting Pins, Machingers Quilting Gloves, Quilting on a Roll patterns, Borders Made Easy, Golden Threads quilting paper, miscellaneous marking pens and pencils, Kwik Klip basting tool, miscellaneous quilting stencils.

**607. Gone Fishin' Panel Quilt:** Holly Taylor Northern Shores fabric from Moda, Triangles on a Roll. (Instructions for *Gone Fishin'* quilt are in the May/June 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**608. Embroidery Stitch Recipes:** #34/34C and 20/20C Bernina® presser feet, Bernina Designer Plus software, OESD Ultra Clean & Tear stabilizer, HR5 temporary spray adhesive, Build Your Own Plaid pattern by Susan Cleveland.

**609. State Fair Blue Ribbon Quilts:** No special supplies.

**610. Cute Chenille Appliqué:** Chenille By the Inch™ and Chenille Kit from Fabric Café, June Taylor Chenille Shortcuts, Collins fusible thread. (Instructions for *Cuddly Caterpillar* quilt are in July/August 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**611. Longarm Quilting 101:** American Professional Quilting Systems Millenium longarm quilting machine, Sulky and Superior threads.

**612. Pre-Quilted Backpack:** Size 16/100 machine needle, Bernina® walking foot. (Instructions for backpack are in March/April 2005 issue of *Love of Quilting*.)

**613. Basic Borders:** No special supplies.
