

QUILT DESIGN: Holiday Sweatshirt

HOLIDAY Sweatshirt

Adorn a comfy warm sweatshirt with funky trees and sparkling jewels!

MATERIALS

NOTE: Fabrics in the project shown are from the Poodles Noel collection by Jersey Girls for Lyndhurst Studio.

3 (6") squares in light pink print, black plaid, and dark pink print for trees

3" x 11" rectangle white print for snow

3" square black print for tree trunks

Paper-backed fusible web

Approximately 3 dozen fusible rhinestones

Tear-away stabilizer

Cutting

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Patterns for appliqué pieces are on page 2-3. Follow manufacturer's instructions for using fusible web.

From light pink print, cut:

- 1 Tree A.

From black plaid, cut:

- 1 Tree B.

From dark pink print, cut:

- 1 Tree C.

From white print, cut:

- D.

From black print, cut:

- 3 Tree Trunks.

Block Assembly

1. Referring to photo, position appliqué pieces on front of sweatshirt; fuse pieces in place.
2. Topstitch pieces ⅛" inside edge of each piece with matching thread.

Sew Smart™

Use tear-away stabilizer on bottom to prevent stretching.

3. Fuse rhinestones to trees.

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Patterns are shown full size and are reversed for use with fusible web. Add $\frac{3}{16}$ " seam allowance for hand appliqué.

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
